

Covid Safety Measures

Welsh Labour puts the safety of the public and delegates at conference first. Please make sure you play your part by reading and following this together with other guidance.

Following the latest guidance issued by Welsh Government and a detailed risk assessment by staff, we have put in place the following measures to ensure the safety and comfort of delegates, visitors and party and venue staff.

COVID passes

Everyone over the age of 18 attending conference will be **required to provide EITHER evidence of double vaccination, a recent negative lateral flow test or proof of natural immunity.**

Attendees will be required to provide a valid NHS COVID Pass at entry. An NHS COVID pass can be obtained here (<https://gov.wales/get-your-nhs-covid-pass>)

We will not be providing rapid lateral flow tests on site, however a list of nearby pharmacies is available here (<https://maps.test-and-trace.nhs.uk/#/location/LL30%201BB>)

Attendees should not attend the event if required to self-isolate. Attendees should also not attend where they are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 but have taken a rapid lateral flow test, the result of which is negative.

If you have a medical reason which means you cannot be vaccinated or tested, you may let us know on entry (we will not ask for any proof of this medical exemption).

If you begin to experience symptoms of COVID-19 at the event, we kindly ask that you leave the event and do not interact with other attendees or staff.

If you test positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of attending the event, please notify us as soon as possible by contacting 07877 652889. Please include details of anybody with whom you came into close contact at the event and provide us with a contact number, so that we may discuss this with you. If you are identified as a close contact of somebody who tested positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of attending the event, we will contact you as soon as we are able.

Face Masks

Welsh Labour strongly advise that attendees wear face coverings when moving around the building and when seated during the conference. This does not include times where attendees are in areas where eating and drinking is permitted, or when speaking on the main platform.

As well as encouraging the use of face coverings, there will be extra precautionary measures in place. Hand sanitisers will be available at rooms' entrances, within all rooms and in catering areas.

Social Distancing

Welsh Labour ask that attendees be mindful of others' personal space when interacting with them and when moving around the building.

Temporary barriers may be installed outside the main entrance to manage queues.

A one-way system will be in place at conference entrance/exit. Please listen to stewards instructions.
